Whoever has not seen with closed eyes, should not expect to see with open eyes. This world is vast. If you remain busy picking faults you will not find anyone righteous. When you are striving to find the righteous people, you won't have time to find faults in other people. O man! All of us have hidden faults; when you start peeping inside your own Nafs, you will realize your own faults and the world will seem faultless; Sufis call this state *Vilayat*.

(Your) work in the path of love never ends. Finish one task and another begins. Even the obligations of love are truly mesmerizing; the more you draw the thread of love, the farther your destination is. Neither you will have your heart's fill, nor your divine journey will ever end. Only your location changes.

Only those who jump into the flames of love, end up attaining the status of Wilayat (Association with Allah). How can one claim (Divine) friendship when one doesn't know how to light a fire?

While the followers of *Tariqat* continue to search for the (Divine) path, *Darwish*es give away their heart (to Allah SWT) and hide from the world.

When the window of consciousness and passion opens, love will begin to descend in the form of *Ilham* and miracles. If you receive divine blessings, keep quiet, and don't share the secrets with the world. Tell only the ones who are aware of your spiritual state. Take care of the desperate and needy people. Utilize your happiness and ecstasy to perform *Dhikr*. Make the worldly people aware of divine love, but do so discretely, for people are very jealous.

What to expect from a societyin which worldly status is all that matters? If we leave the path of humanity to find shortcuts, employ fraud and deception, then one day we and our generations will suffer the consequences.

In a society where boys and girls cannot get married due to dowry and other base demands, we can expect our next generations to end up wandering around the sewerage drains (under narcotic effects).

Just by meeting others with aselfless smile, we can shed a lot of tensions and mental pressure. But how to smile when we have notime for others?

Search is a means of finding. Searching for means is also among means. When means merge and you know that it is the means to salvation, you have found the Creator of all means (*Musababul-Asbab*).

It is one thing to meet everyone. But learning how to meet the One (Allah SWT) who has the power to give everything is a sign of good fortune.

People listen and shake their heads in response, but if someone touches your heart, then your heart will be enlightened (spiritually).

Some want to meet, others come to get answers, and some come to seek (divine love). People get what they come for.

If a friend start playing upon words, know that friendship and love are being replaced withself-interest.

Both life and death are useless without purpose. When one cannot understand the purpose of life, then one is as good as an animal.

Vilayat is the legacy of the Auliya-e-Allah. The one known to the world as Haider-e-Karrar, about whom the Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم) said, "grudge towards him is a sign of hypocrisy". Love for him is the hallmark of faith, and the true definition of *Vilayat*.

Friends, if you think broadly, you will expand your horizon. If your thinking is limited, you will remain confined in every walk of life, whether in action, knowledge, reasoning, society, wealth or fame, and even in the case of love. You become what you believe in.

A master is one who can make another a master without the world knowing about them. Take refuge in the oneness of Allah SWT, anddive into the sea of love for His beloved (صلى الله عليه وسلم). Then encourage others to follow.

How you see someone is based on your perception. But if some Wali-Allah sets his eyes on you, it is a divine blessing. When you look at something, it is pure coincidence, but can change your fate.

This is anage of impatience. People with differing ideologies will try to irritate you so they can take pleasure in your resentment. But if you keep cool and appear happy in front of these people, that day will mark your victory and their defeat.

This is the trait of the *Fakirs*: whoever embraced (spiritual) awareness, shunned (the desires of) the Nafs, and accepted trials of life as a part of his training, will emerged as a successful person.

Our society is to be blamed entirely for our training. Our people are only being taught the skills of arguing and criticizing, whether it is a school, a dargah, or any other popular training place. If we reform the society in the light of the teachings of our Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم), many (of our social) problems can be solved.

Love begets love; how can hatred understand the secret of love?

Conflict and reconciliation are part of life. It is not a big deal. But whoever remains patient haswon.

People are mad in love with this world butcall us mad. They pretend to be wise. No complaints. But these who to pretend to be wise look for recommendations from the very men who they think are mad.

Thought transcends the distance between near and far, but the thought must contain an element of understanding, as it turns the disorders of the Nafs to ashes.

There will be some close friends who will attempt to deceive you through hypocrisy. But time moves on. Even if they try to turn around, it would be too late. Loyalty is a rare commodity in this double-faced world.

Lovers don't forget. Hatred is forgotten quickly because it is so rampant. On the other hand, love is rare and entire lives are spent in the pursuit of love.

If you set your sights on worldly things, you will go astray, and you will be seduced by their outward beauty and glamour, forcing you to do everything in your power to acquire them. Even if you manage to acquire them at the cost of your life's comfort and peace, you will be surprised to realize what lies inside the fancy packing. But it will already be too late to repent over the lost time, as your body will be too weak and old to support you anymore, leaving you alone withremorse. There's still time, friends, come back (towards Allah SWT).

Dhikr means remembering. Those who remember (Allah SWT) will be remembered, and those who don't will be forgotten. Why acknowledge later that you ignored the worthy and remembered unworthy things? Better to think of remembering One in whom the entire world reposes hopes for blessings. So, friends! Think of whom to remember and whom not to! This philosophy is very simple.

Just as facial expressions can betray truth or a lie, the fragrance of love (can also be sensed easily) as it flourishes.

The Sufis always start with themselves, reforming their own selvesfirst by putting a leash on their Nafs, and thenstart preaching to other people tobring social change. That is why, despite passage of centuries, their words soothe people and attract them towards their message.

As long as you remember your name and caste, you cannot consider yourself as a student of divine love. Killing your ego is the only way to find (your beloved)

We dress well and show our selfies to friends and people. But why have we never tried to show our character? Why are we indulging ourselves in the exhibition of our dresses and fancy vehicles? (Do you think) people are crazy and they don't know how you amassed this wealth? These (testing) times require that we spend our time in the service of mankind, and in sharing their sorrows. Share their suffering and (believe me), you will look beautiful regardless of your dress.

Those who struggle only for their selfinterests ultimately get tired and are forgotten. But those who strive for others, the entire world runs after them.

The heart shakes in remembrance, thus a seeker writhes in his quest.

If people from different schools of thought unite against you, know you are on the path of truth. And congratulations to you in advance, you have won and the impatient have lost.

If someone comes so far in enmity that they hate even hearing your name, then understand that Allah plans to bless your name with honor.

When community members start copying your style out of jealousy, (it means that) your triumph has made them uneasy.

Loyalty results in blessings, disloyalty results in separation; There is misery and narrow-mindedness in hatred, and lust and desire in jealousy. Everything other than loyalty stems from hypocrisy.

A man doesn't become black until his heart turns dark (with sins).

Love does not allow lovers to ask questions. Just the gaze and gestures of the beloved are enough to entice the lover, and the helpless victim (of love) loses everything in the quest to find his love. And then, keeps telling his stories of love to others. Some think he is crazy; others call him *Darwish*, some believe heis a *Fakir*, but only those who fall in love themselves will truly understand.

What is beauty? Go ask its victims. What's the point of asking those who haven't seen beauty at all? Those, who don't know that beauty is time less? The intoxication caused by beauty never fades away from the lover's eyes.

People criticize us for doing *Dhamal* for our beloved. But what can we do friends? When the feet our beloved step on our heart it starts to dance, and the helpless body trembles with it. This is what you call a *Dhamal*.

If no solace were offered by love at all, the helpless lovers would continue to cry till their graves.

As long as you have a flame of jealousy and self-mischief within you, understand that you are still Satan's follower in a human disguise.

Unless you trust yourself, and stop thinking about what will happen to you, or what you will do, know that you're still a beginner in the path of love.

To think of yourself as praiseworthy and believing in it is the first mistake that makes you fall. And this is where your decline begins.

Mischief in love is called *Shirk*, and such form of Shirk is called *Kufr*. A disbeliever cannot be part of a festival of love. To enter it, one must shun dissentions. Who so ever brought this evil with him (will not be able to enter) and will only observe the world of lovers from a far with longing (to enter).

Tell the ignorant about pain (in love). What is the point of telling those who already know?

Don't be arrogant; instead, bow down! The one who bows will rise.

In reality, failure in worldly love is actually the search for divine love.

When a man strives to understand the intricacies of life, understand that he has developed passion for spirituality.

Tariqat is when a man tries to free himself of the complexities of worldly affairs, and after wandering and getting deceived, develops the inclination to understand the reality.

When a human becomes content on something, it is (the understanding of) reality.

Understanding yourself is like understanding the entire universe. How can you understand others when you haven't understood yourself?

When you exceed the limits of flattery and criticism, understand that you have lost your (life's) path at a cross road.

No matter how much knowledge and intellect you have, you cannot be a remarkable human being unless you have training. So, acquire the company of a specialist trainer.

Don't try to appear pious to the world; instead, be pious in front of Allah SWT, your piety will be known to the world.

Blindness of the society will only end with the growth of humanity.

Glad tidings are useless without seeing (the beloved). If one sees his beloved, all the sorrow and worries are washed away.

We (followers of the Qalandar) do not believe in customs; we believe in association (with our beloved).

Try to become pious a thousand times, but believe me, if the fire of jealousy and resentment remains inside you it will always burn that piety to ashes.

Nomentally ill person will admit his illness. Likewise, if we accept ourselves as victims of social issues, a lot of problems will be solved.

Whoever looks back in life, will fail. The one who continues travelling forward (without looking back) will reach the destination.

There are two types of lies; those that bring reconciliation and love, and others that instigate dissention and hatred.

There are two types of sins: those done consciously and those done unconsciously. Avoid the former sins and refrain from the latter.

Kashf knows the secret between a no and yes, but it's like a web: the one inside it can see outside but the outsiders can not see the interior.

The farther you stay from hungry wolves and overfed humans, the safer you will be.

The ablution of love is patience. It is tested in the face of evil and mischief to detect which latter one needs solitude. Evil lies within you and works surreptitiously. The *Sufis* call it the *Nafs*.

Filth in thought is more dangerous than physical and social filth; it pollutes yours' and others' knowledge and intellect.

Sometimes, we come across strange fellows. They try to enhance their worth by criticizing others.

How can one sleep when there is worry and longing in the eyes and no peace of mind? And how can we expect to are looking for it in the wrong place?

The more you run from arrogance, the more arrogant people you will come across. This is a sign of your lofty stature and noble personality.

The more you seek fame, the more humiliation you will face.

Hopeless people who are unhappy with Divine distribution express their negative mentality through words that reflect their own failure and deprivation. And then, without realization, the listeners play up these words and actions. Suicide is just a matter of time for such people, and their end is humiliating. Such people remain unhappy because they fail to understand the secrets of the Creator and talk aim lessly.

The world is a two-ways treet full of strife. Some enter and some leave. Some think of this world as a joke while others take it seriously. Here, you will reap whatever you sow. The cycle continues; some gotlost mid-way, others get abandoned by their own people. Some left their sorrows in this world, while others took them along to the next world

Rigid minds canneverbe cleaned because they are imprinted firmly with ideas and beliefs. Such minds can only be cleaned if they distance themselves from their pre-existing ideas and beliefs.

When dogs bit dogs we learned to live in the dwellings where humans bite humans. There, the pious abuse the bad ones to make them pious. There discussions take place when and how to cut throats for good, the wicked are seen being abused. We are slaves of that unshakable selfishness which dictates only personal gain. Loss is only for the poor and the weak. We chantAllaah's name to pleaseHim but annoy His slaves. We ask for His Mercy while we mistreat his creation. We are the intellectuals and preachers whose deeds run contrary to their words. We follow leaders who teach us chaos instead of morality. We think anyone who does not lie and cheat, is an idiot.

We are the educated people who fight like children. in front of the whole world on a mere toy (wealth). We are the young generation who sleep when people leave for business. We are old men who used to be earning in the factories and now we have been sold as junk by our children. We are leaders who make our followers fight others but at the top we remain united. We have become the city that is actually like a cemetery, where there is no principle or reform. We are the holy place where entry demands subservience to some earthly god. We are the agricultural farms whose produce is mixed with mud. We do the unthinkable sinsin cemetery as if we are never to be buried here. The hot desert sand is now here as hot as the fire of jealousy inside us. We are the intellectuals who bite each other like dogs.

If you give away your heart to this world, you will always be deceived. But if you deceive this world, you will find loyalty in the form of eternity (the hereafter).

It is difficult to call a spade a spade. Often you have to use round about words.

When knowledge and pen go into hands of carefree people, then no love, but only chaos can be expected.

Extremism, whether academic, literary or religious, always causes deterioration in the society.

When the hidden black crow insideus starts crowing, it won't sing sweetly like peacocks, but will only spread egoism and jealousy.

Developing relationships is a tiring task whether with this world or with Allah.

Friends! There are so many reasons to worry. One is that a man thinks he is better and right, and others are wrong. However, if one sits down and seriously thinks about himself, he will find all the faults present in himself. But the conceit of Nafs makes him consider himself good and others useless. Those who pamper him he honours them, and those who point out his weaknesses, he distances himself from them. Friends, this is a serious ailment which will harm you. Avoid this contagious disease. When you have the option to pray to Allah and praise His Prophet (SAW), do so. Practice humility, have faith, and do not bother about what others do or think. Your worries will disappear.

It is everyone's right to disagree, object or even deny. But it is not our practice to cross the limits of morality. Our history, culture and religious tolerance do not allow one to achieve hisobjectives hurting others. Doing so will lead to a grudge that will be harmful to the People of our region who have always deeply loved the Holy Prophet and followed his teachings. We should not interfere in others' personal matters and create trouble.

Many people living in the world don't even think, nor does it occur to them that this world in which we are walking will end. That it is atemporary abode is realized only when the call comes. But to their good luck they have another Ramazan coming. So get down to populating both this and the next world, pleading and praying to Allah, give up sins, and practice excess of Durood..

The trial begins when you are denied your request. In such times if you take your trials as your reformation, and show patience, doors will start opening.

If you don't acknowledge your mistake, it will be a major mistake. Not to understand the great people of your time is a mistake. These invaluable people will not stay in this world forever.

If a man is not able to become a fakir in the company of a fakir, it is as if one failed to become by living in company of the rich, and then realized that this companionship was only to pass time.

Don't take a failure as failure. It is the key that will help you achieve success. Just take courage and move forward with patience.

Cold and desire are the same thing. Cold shrinks the body and desire burn the soul.

When a passion changes to love, itcan spoil your life. But if the love is for those who are in realloveit is good luck. Because those who know love will explain the secret of loving from their experience.

Great are those young men who live their youth with restraint, reject the desires with patience and courage, polish their inner self and achieve the high morals of humanity. With their humility they will win disbelieving hearts and be remembered till the end of the world.

When a man's up bringing, thoughts and consciousness fall asleep or begin to fall asleep, know that not only is he a failed man but will also drag the whole society with him. Your deeds can kill. Be a benefactorand not harmful to the world. Become as if you do not exist with no desire but to become a slave of those who know how to turn a slave into king.

There are ups and downs in life. What Hands cause those (ups and downs)? We want to find thoseHands.

No teacher disappears, theyremain with you in terms of your thoughts and ideas. Looking for the Truth without a teacher is like knocking on a closed door of an empty house.

There is a difference between company and solitude. Solitary people are not used to company and company lovers do not know the worth of solitude.

A single 'no' that protects you from a number of evils, is better than multiple failed promises.

Repentance is the cure for all spiritual and social diseases.

Sincerity begins to die when the sincere one becomes jealous with those he was himself sincere with.

Passion (falling in love) deprives the logical man of all his knowledge and wisdom.

Learners are the heirs of the teacher. Beware of what you learn. Choose your teacher carefully looking at his (spiritual) association and his attitude.

Minor evil also indicates a strong evil behind it. It will cause evil. So, minor or major, evil is evil.

How will you find your destination if you leave the company of your guide?

Talking about love for the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon Him) without Durood for Him is like hitting cold iron (wasting effort).

If you are lucky enough to reach company of a holy person do not leave until the sitting is over. Such opportunities are hard to get.

You learn everything when in contact with those who know. Whether physical or spiritual, past, present, or future. So, look for those who know.

The coastal storm will go, Insha Allah. The real tsunami is of temptations and strife that occur because of our own desires. How to deal with it? Just think how to eject that garbage away from our homes and society.

Occurrences leave their marks and stains. Soaps of this world only clean the stains, but how can small pox scars be removed? Hypocrisy is a disease worse than smallpox.

One forgets the comforts of the past. But pain of being betrayed never leaves you. Deception by friends! Biting like snake and scorpion while hugging! Sweet talk full of honey and poison in reality! How can you forget these scars? Joint selfies in public and enmity in the background? How to get memories of such secret attacks out of your heart?

Karbala's outward and inner victory has shown forever that the loser won, and the winner lost along with his like-minded people. Hussainism is an undeniable truth that will shine like the sun, while Yazeedism is falsehood and deception that will ever be humiliated.

The greatest hurdle in the path of good is jealousy that deprives you of humility and tolerance.

Friends! In this age of tribulations excess of Durood is like a pivot in a machine (or an anchor for a boat) that can hold us safe around it. Try to hold on to this practice.

Do we need an argument for practicing and propagating the practice of Durood? Should we not receive and spread the Rehmat (Mercy, blessing)? Can there be any other blessing better than it in this world of misery?

Where the path of self-mischief is blocked, the Gates of mercy and blessings open when the evil of Nafs (ego, self) is suppressed.

Rules of the world, the principles of lawand religion, formalities of caste, colorand of the society are essential for man to live in any society. You will find a set of laws in every school, office, and institution which must be followed. The fact is the world is run by the law. It is another matter that there is no law for the powerful. They use the law against the less powerful and the weak. Power is supreme. Allah's law enforces itself and suddenly and without warning, giving justice to both the oppressed and the wrong doers. Temporary difficulties are part of Law of the Lord. Delays in relief do not mean one should lose hope. History is awitness that the wrongdoer has been destroyed by his own wrong doing, and the victim has been elevated by the Lord Almighty. Of course, there must be perseverance and uniformity which is called "sabr" (patience).

What will aman achieve if he continues to change allegiances running after solution of everchanging worldly issues? It is like trying to remain in shade from the sun. He cannot stop at one place but will have to change his place as the shadows shift. Shouldn't he have taken one position where the shadow is permanent (work for the eternal life)? The fun and comforts of the world are like monsoon rains, flooding here and no drop there.

Those who stick to one philosophy are worthy of praise. People quote their words and convey those to future generations. Their names echo in history. On the other side, those with temporary interests disappear with time. No praise, no memory in history. The faithful stand by their promise (to Allah). Suffering hardships is tradition of prophets, saints, and the "Ahle-Bait" (members of the inner family of the Holy Prophet, PBUH). The world can never forget their actions. Only those who stood fast in difficulties became immortal.

They say that ghosts also run away from beatings, like our government officials from NAB (national Accountability Bureau). Landlords are nothing without authority Pirs (spiritual mentors) nothing without assistants (to support their system).

In love, there are principles for the principled and sincerity for the unprincipled. When the latter come in contact with us our sincerity will undo their faults and polish up their character.

When the trend arises in society to frighten and awe others, all available methods and resources are employed. Look at the waybig countries that have always been powerful, always try to trap the weaker nations. Sometimes they claim violations of human rights and sometimes unique accusations of actions are imposed, which are legal if they do themselves and crime if the weaker nations do the same. That is because they have power, and they are proud of it. All these tactics are used as tried recipes to establish their supremacy. Similarly, when a man strives to humiliate another human being, he crosses all limits but in so doing digs a well in which he will ultimately fall themself.

Why are our young people setting their youth on fire by envying the bungalows and beauty of others? To the extent that they are blaming Allah for not helping while they are performing prayers and the Durood. And they say they will not do this (prayers and durood) in future. Is it that they are trying to challenge the law of Allah? If they continue the result will be that all their good deeds will be wiped out. They will get neither Allah nor this world. Pity the man of today who is in such a hurry to fulfill his desires!

In old days sleuths traced foot marks of the thief backwards to the place he came from. Times have changed; modes of theft and investigation have also changed (with the advent of technologies) like vehicle trackers, cameras, CCTV, etc. The explorers searched for the marks of the thief's feet upside down. That is, not on the foot of the way to go, but on the way to the coming. Then, when times changed, thefts also became modern and so did the way footprints were found, such as tracing trackers and using CCTV cameras: the modern tactics. But thefts are also modern. Early poets used to say that their heart had been stolen, and the person who stole was known. Present-day thief is sitting on social media. The location is also shownbut it is false. The identity is changed and so is the sex. When the police arrive (to capture the thief), the whole information turns out to be false.

Comforts come after trials. No one attains a position without examinations. Suffering comes to everyone. Those who are patient do not tell (of their suffering) but listen. Those who get used to telling (their suffering) keep crying.

The introduction of any personality is his role and contribution. For example, Data Ganj Bakhsh RAH is known for his book Kashaf al-Mahioob. The introduction of Imam Ghazali RAH is his book "Keemia e S'aadat" (The Recipe of Success). So, the role, contributions, words of a person will continue to introduce him for centuries "كنت مولا "the words. The words of the Holy prophet" are sufficient to introduce Hazrat Ali and the Holy Quran is sufficient introduction to the Holy prophet Himself (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him). The words "I am from Hussain and Hussain is from me" sufficiently introduce Imam Hussein. Enemies will do their best to tarnish these images but will fail. Let them pour out poison. Did Abu Jahl not try his best? Did Yazid leave any stone unturned? The circle of jealousy will continue to grow in the shadow of hatred, but these identities will shine unblemished for ever. "AhleBait" are like the Arc of Nuh, whoever climbed into it remained safe.

When man begins to develop animal needs in place ofhuman instincts, there will certainly be a need for bowels of a large animal in place of the human intestine. If you start playing triple innings in an unending game of lust and desire, the batting line behind can only waste time waiting. Then if they start another game, and the same greedy players jump in again you can't expect any good.

When cattle herders set out to graze cattle, and one odd animal were in the habit of deviating from the herd the owner would tie a bell around its neck so that if it left the herd, sound of the bell would tell where it was grazing. That strategy was successful then. Now the bells have changed as result of modern technology. But spiritual connections can judge the heart and the soul as to how sincere or otherwise a person is.Is he a performer with few words or is he a verbose man with no performance?

Today, when the audience saw Darwish crying and praying for the assembly to pass the job and the test, the audience with Darwish cried, then on the other hand, look at the deceptions and arrogance of the dual-faced and deceitful men of the living and the impure who were cutting lines by making snake rope for their own interests. Someone cut the line of spirituality, someone cut the line of politics. Then cut off the line of Sufism and religion, but the poor man is still in pain except for their prayers and those of the righteous.

Don't just doubt. Try to understand and all doubts will be cleared.

The family of the Beloved Karim (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) struggled for the sake of the religion of His maternal grandfather so that He may not be unhappy with them on the Day of Judgement. And to avoid the whole Muslim community permanently adopt a wrong principle out of fear and harassment. Lest the Muslim community leave the Islamic laws and get trapped for ever in deceptions of this world.

People talk about sacrificing their lives, but the standard of sacrifice was set by Imam Hussain who saw infants of his family being killed, and young men coming straight out of marriage bed bravely facing the oppressor and laying down their lives. Only he deserves to be termed as "Razi be Raza", or absolutely content with Allah's Will.

This was not a quarrel over wealth or property of this world. It was a loud statement of Hussainismthat was all over the Earth and the Heavens. That voice of faith will continue to be heard and to create a stir in the hearts of cowards.

Just the fear of death prevents a person from sins and will not allow him to be selfish. It will keep the heart from arrogance and misdeeds. This can only be achieved through abundance of Durood and remembrance of Allah, especially, the "zikr e Oalbi"

He who does not learn how to get up will surely have difficulty sitting, but he will have to do both acts. Life must be lived. One must faceups and downs; come across obstacles and ease. If you do not persevere, you will still have to go through them. If you act like an unwilling and stubborn horse and do not move forward either the master will starve you or lash you. Then you will have to look fora way out.

Will chewing betel nutwrapped in the leaves of Aak give you the taste? Any level of progress obtained through manipulation will always be invalid.

Without human moral values no one can become a great man or a leader except by some divine purpose. In order to learn human moral values, one must study the life of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) who set the highest standard of human morality.

Hur RA the commander sent by Abdullah to the border of Babylon came unaware of the truth to the battle field Thursday, 1st of Muharram 61 Hijri (680 AD) with tongues of soldiers and horses stuck out due to thirst. Despite knowing (that they were sent to fight him) Imam Hussain (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) gave themwater from their scanty reserve collected by Abbas. When truth dawned on him, the mind of Hur turned. The secret behind this reversal is the greatness of character demonstrated by Imam Hussein (may Allaah have mercy on him) which let Hur see the truth.

The alphabet of love begins with the family of the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) and climaxes as Karbala. No one can claim or demonstrate such strength of faith.

The reason and philosophy of the great sacrifice of Imam Husain (AS) and Ahl al-Bayt should be highlighted. But the message must be spread while preaching unity and cohesion and avoiding emotional slogans, rituals and accusations that cause dissentions among Muslims.

Hussaini philosophy is one of love and affection. He claimed nothing but what was due. Hypocrites and the faithful will always present together. Not to worry about them. People like those who built another mosque in the very presence of the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him); could object to the division of Bait-ul-Mal by the Sadiq and Amin the greatest leaderever; and could stand behind Him in prayers hiding idols under their arms, will also be treatedfollowing the same philosophy as of the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him). If we deviate, we will harm this philosophy and the message.

Friends! Enough to understand. O Ali, The Lion of Allah! You and your progeny will always be fielded against armies where you have to show patience and forbearanceto disbelievers as well as believers. That is todemonstrate the meaning of the words of the Last Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him): "Ali is Maula (ally, supporter) of one whose maula Lam". That is love and faith.

Can the family of the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) think of dividing the ummah? But hypocrites will be revealed. He (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) had himself said, "Grudge against Ali distinguishes hypocrite from the believer". This hadeeth is the best test if someone wants to investigate.

Family of the Messenger (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) is a blessing of Allahcharacterized by forgiveness. No place for blame and curse there. Whoever came to them was forgiven. The very purpose of the sacrifice by the Imam (AS) was for forgiveness of sinners. But do people understand this? We are rather bursting with gunpowder of hate.

Pledging obedience to this wicked man (Yazeed) by Imam Hussein (AS) alone would be treated as a pledge by the entire family of the Prophet PBUH. That would be tantamount to victory of untruth over truth forever. Could Imam Hussein (AS), who grew up in the lap of the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him), allow that?

Maula Ali (AS) and Imam Hussain (AS) were both unique. None was ever born or will be born like them. Ali (AS) had the honor of being son-in-law of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon Him) and Hussain (AS) had the unique distinction of riding on His shoulders and playing in his lap. Courage is needed to acknowledge this.

It is people like Hur (who came out of the unfortunate Koofians themselves) that achieve eternal success and made it clear to the Tyrant Yazeed that Hussain (AS) was not interested in worldly power. That Hussain (AS) was interested in eternal success and would continue to create many Hurs out of so many stray people until the Day of Resurrection.

Such things (matyrdom of Hussain, AS) have been happening over the centuries. Some simply forgot them as a matter of the past. That is their own luck. The correct attitude is to interpret his sacrifice at karbala in the light of the Quran and orders by the holy Prophet PBUH leaving aside all fabricated philosophies and practices.

It's a matter of time. What we believe today may not be right in the morning. What seems wrong today may prove to be right the next morning. Similarly, our likes and dislikes will change over time. We must regard the current laws.

Even today Imam Hussain does not belong to any specific group or philosophy. Imam Hussain (AS) is anideology, a philosophy, and a voice of truth, which had no hatred nor greed for any worldly power. He was an off-spring of the emperor (SAW), who was sent as the guide as Allah's kindness to the whole universe. Why would he need power over this world of mischief? Karbala was a battle of ideologies: of evil and good, falsehood and truth, and of love against resentment, jealousy, deception and hatred.

Talking of Truth in human history, the name of imam Hussain (AS) will always come at the top of the list. If people ponder over it, whether friend or foe, they will conclude that the perfect sacrifice was offered by the blood line of the Holy Prophet PBUH. Whoever gets an opportunity starts grabbing regardless of his rank like workers swooping in on food at a political feast. No one cares for anyone until they have devoured whatever they could lay their hands on. Then, once they come to their senses, they say "they were all my friends. But what can I do?" I must take care of myself and my family" On such occasions few care for even children. They may even crush children like an intoxicated elephant.Party workers are remembered only when needed while the leaders enjoy.

When a man comes to know in which type of company means safety, which path isclear of thorns, the journey becomes easier. And such awarenessitself is great wealth.

The seekers find their path. Sand covers those who sit. Springs can be found in the desert provided one tries. The defeatist psychology possessed by the weak and dismayed human beings makes them useless. Hardworkers reach where others cannot. Only those whose hearts have drank the cup of faith will create shrines. The rest will be listening to taunts of their wives in the kitchen and flattering them for a cup of tea.

There must be a key to every goal. Where there are multiple types of theft there are multiple types of keys. An officer will definitely struggle for a key, e.g., a recommendation, for promotions or a good seat. A politician will run after a key to acquire the ticket of a strong party or a higher position. The real scheme for achievement, worldly or spiritual, is to find the Key and then retain it.

Man is a thief and a guard simultaneously. The thief is his Nafs (desires) and the guard is the spirit. The devil creates an imbalance between the two. One sins when the devil feeds the Nafs and strengthens itor starves the spirit and weakens it. That is his mode of theft. Behind all such thefts are devilish faces, actions and causes. Forgivers will keep forgiving others. Complainers will keep crying and taunting throughout their lives.

Your downfall starts when you deviate from principles and develop personal enmity. Then your sincerity gets replaced by a desire for revenge. But that is the time to forgive. If you manage that you will be safe. Else, you will be lost.
